We use both internal and external resources to monitor and review our security procedures. Our employees are trained and required to safeguard your information.

When we ask you for information it will be used solely for the purpose of providing you with the best service possible. We will be happy to tell you how we use the information we are asking you to provide. Because of the financial nature of our business, our materials, services and websites are not designed to appeal to children under the age of 13. We do not knowingly request or receive any information from children.

We have limited relationships with third parties to assist us in servicing you. We work with several banks to provide the electronic transactions for our services. We do not share your personal information with anyone outside of Right On The Money LLC for their promotional or marketing use. All third parties with whom we share information are required to maintain the confidentiality of the information we provide them to provide similar security safeguards.

We will, as part of our services, provide your personal information to various Federal and State taxing authorities and to your insurance carrier for the purpose of completing your worker's compensation audit. We may disclose your information if we are required to by a law enforcement action such as a court order, subpoena or search warrant.
